WED 2010 around the world

The urgency to better manage the world's wealth of species and ecosystems is a key theme of WED 2010. Despite promising results from conservation efforts around the world, species are still becoming extinct at the fastest rate known in geological history, and most of these extinctions are tied to human activity.

Under the rallying cry 'Many Species, One Planet, One Future', WED 2010 aims to mobilize more people than ever with a wide range of activities focused on conserving biodiversity – from school tree-planting events to community clean-ups, bird-watching trips, exhibits, national green campaigns and much more.

The global host for WED 2010 celebrations on 5 June is Rwanda, in Africa. From Europe to Central Asia, national and local governments, the UN family, corporations and other partners are planning exciting activities focused in the regional hubs of Baku (Azerbaijan), Geneva (Switzerland), Genova (Italy) and beyond.
